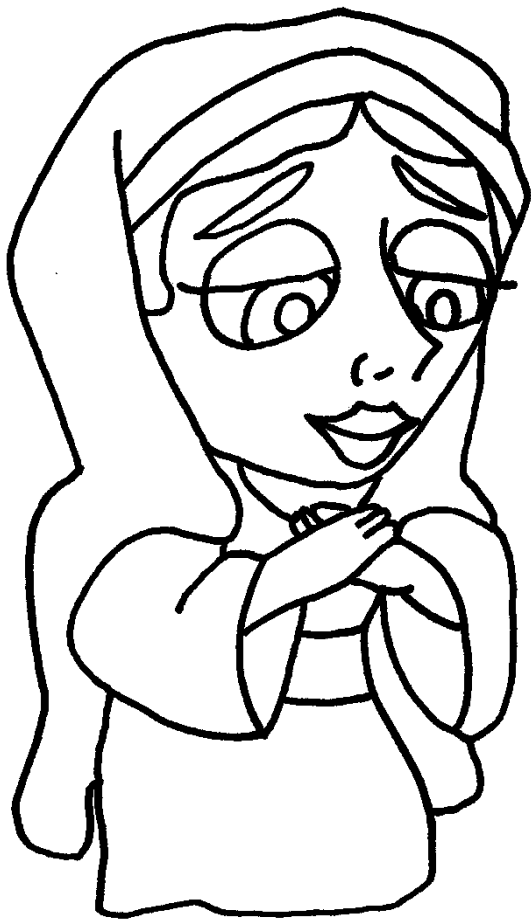


Hannah Prays: 1 Samuel 1:9-27

- What did Eli think about Hannah at first? What did he tell her to do?
- Did Hannah get what she prayed for? How did she care for Samuel?
- Where did Hannah bring Samuel? Who did he serve?

GOD'S STORY, MY STORY: ELCA Book of Faith Devotional Questions

- What scares, confuses, or challenges me in this story? What do I have questions about?
- What delights me in this story? What brings me comfort? What is my favorite part, and why?
- What stories or memories does this story stir up in me? You might remember someone in your life who is good at praying, for example.
- What is God up to in this story? What is God calling you to do or to be? What is God doing here?

PRAYER: Powerful God, sometimes we are worried. Help us to remember that you are with us always, that you hear our prayers, and that we have much to be thankful for. In Jesus' name we pray, Amen.
